RE: Resolution R-073024-1: Michigan Titanium Road Closure Request

Background:

The Tris4Health/Michigan Endurance Holdings LLC coordinates several events statewide including the Grand Rapids Triathlon and the Michigan Titanium. The Michigan Titanium race begins in Plainfield Township but includes a small portion in Ada Township. I have enclosed the request and supporting materials from Michigan Endurance Holdings LLC for road closure requests for their event to be held August 11-12th.

The closure request is for the following:

• Grand River Drive from Stiles Creek Dr. to 3 Mile Rd.

The Township has hosted this event for several years and has not had any issues with granting the road closure request in the past.

If approved by the Township Board, staff will forward to the Kent County Road Commission.




By definition "transition" is the change between the three triathlon disciplines, and the "transition area" is a fenced off area containing the bike racks. It is where you place all your equipment before your race for changing over from swimming to cycling and cycling to running. For many races there is a single transition area.

Swim Course – 1.2 Mile Loop Two Loops – Ultra One Loop – Half




Bike Course – 56 Mile Loop


Ultra – Two Laps
