

COMMUNITY CAMPOUT FAQs

Q: What kind of camping is allowed?

A: Tent camping only.
No RVs or campers are allowed

Q: How many people/tents are allowed in each campsite?

A: Each campsite can hold a maximum of 2 tents and up to six people.

Q: What is included in my campsite fee?

A: All items in the schedule are included!

Q: Is there electricity at my campsite?

A: No electricity is available at the campsites. Generators are not allowed at the campout.

Q: Do we need to supply all our own camping gear?

A: All campsites are responsible for providing their own camping gear. See the list below for our recommendations

Q: Can I bring my own grill?

A: No external grills are allowed. Campers may utilize the permanent charcoal grills located around Ada Park.

Q: Are speakers allowed?

A: Small Bluetooth speakers are allowed outside of quiet time.

Q: Are pets allowed?

A: This is a pet-free event

Q: Should I participate if I have never been camping?

A: This event is a great opportunity for beginners and young kids to experience camping and sleeping outdoors!

Q: What is freeplay?

A: Ada Parks & Recreation staff will provide equipment to use various areas of the park including the ball diamonds, pickleball courts, nature trails, and fishing pond!

Q: Is alcohol allowed at the campout?

A: Alcohol is not allowed at the Community Campout

Q: Do we need to bring any food with us?

A: Campsites will have meals provided for dinner (Sept. 13) and breakfast (Sept. 14). Snacks are provided for the bonfire and the movie. Campers are welcome to bring their own snacks for the movie and bonfire if desired.

Q: What restroom facilities are on-site?

A: Ada Park has restroom facilities with running water and multiple port-a-johns on-site. No shower facilities are available at the park

Q: What happens in case of bad weather?

A: Every effort will be made to fulfill the event keeping participant safety in mind. If cancelled, participants will be refunded in full.
