They are located in multiple buildings on multiple lots, have shared parking and driveway access to a public street, and the buildings have a unified or consistent architectural style, character and appearance.")

In the event that any two or more uses fall within more than one of the above categories, for purposes of determining the maximum number and size of freestanding signs, the uses shall be considered as being within a business center comprised of the largest grouping of businesses resulting from any of the characteristics identified above.

Freestanding signs have the following limitations:

- 1. On a lot or parcel having frontage on and vehicular access from one street or on a corner lot, one freestanding sign is permitted.
- 2. On a double frontage lot having vehicular access from both streets, two freestanding signs are permitted.

____ C. Projecting signs:

Proposed area of sign(s) ______sq. ft. Permitted one projecting sign per entry door to a business (excluding an entry door serving more than one business) or two projecting signs per business, whichever is greater, provided the following conditions are met:

a. The sign shall not exceed 6 sq. ft. in area.

- b. There shall be a minimum clearance between the ground and the bottom of the sign of 10 feet, if the sign projects over a public sidewalk.
- c. The sign shall not project more than 4 feet from the building wall, nor extend closer than 2 feet to the curb line.
- d. An individual business premises shall have no more than 1 projecting sign per street or sidewalk frontage.
