

Ada Township Parks - Protocols Due to COVID-19

Protocols are subject to change as directed by the Governor, Michigan Health and Human Services, Kent County Health Department, and the level people adhere to them.

General Access:

- At this time, the park grounds & trails remain open for public access dawn to dusk.
- 6' social distancing is required unless members of the same household.
- Large group events are restricted and need prior approval by the Parks Department.
- Team sports are restricted and need prior approval by the Parks Department.
- When visiting a park or amenity in it, and find it busy, please find another location.

Park Amenities:

- Restrooms are open but only sanitized once a day.
- Playgrounds are open but not sanitized.
- Drinking fountains are closed until further notice.
- Courts are available seasonally closed in the winter
- The outdoor Shelter and Gazebos have limited tables and require social distancing.
- Outdoor picnic tables are available at some locations.
- Indoor facilities are currently not available.

Safety Protocols – Please follow:

- Stay at home if you exhibit symptoms or had contact with someone with the virus.
- Keep travel limited to your local parks and for general health purposes.
- Practice social distancing stay 6' or more apart from other visitors and park staff.
- Wear a mask anytime you are near other people not in your own household.
- Limit outdoor gatherings to just a few people and maintain distance and mask protocols.
- Wash or sanitize your hands before and after visiting parks.
- Keep dogs on a leash and picked up after.
