

Ada Township Amy Van Andel Library & Community Center



Executive Summary

Building Committee was unable to come to a consensus to recommend 1st and 2nd floor space plans or a building exterior design theme. Subsequently, two small subcommittees were created to finalize these schematic design deliverables. On October 30th, Ada Township issued a notice that an alternative site north of Headley needs to be re-evaluated. This was the original location for the Library / Farmers Market facility before moving to a lot on the south side of Headley. As a result, design has stopped until a building site has been confirmed.

Progress This Period

October 2018

- 10/2/18 floor plans submitted.
- 10/8/18 revised floor plans submitted and (4) additional building exterior designs presented
- 10/16/18 community room/kitchen layout options submitted.
- 10/22/18 study rooms pulled away from community room and layout options submitted.
- 10/30/18 Ada Twp issued notice to evaluate another site for library.

Planned For Next Period

November 2018

- CM preparing Schematic Design construction estimate.
- Ada Twp to confirm to keep building at site south of Headley or to relocate building to alternate site north of Headley.
- Resume design process after site selection.
- Re-evaluate budget once site has been confirmed.

Key Issues / Risks / Decisions

- Design: Completion of Schematic Design has been postponed until the building site has been confirmed. Ada Township to review alternate site at a 11/14/18 workshop.
- Budget: Approximately \$9,939,537 of funding is available per Ada Twp. Budget must be maintained throughout the design process.
- Budget: Should building be relocated to alternate site, potential budget increases may include additional work associated with site work, parking lot, storm water retention, landscaping, building foundation and professional design fees.
