He noted that the Township Board has approved the temporary easements on Township property for the temporary bridge span, and that MDOT personnel have been in the field preparing an inventory of existing trees in the easement area.

Ferro noted that at last month's meeting the Board discussed organizing a meeting with the business community to discuss how the community should respond to the bridge project in terms of communicating with the public and marketing the community.

Haga mentioned there is an upcoming meeting of the ABA Board on August 3.

It was agreed that Kullgren would attend the ABA Retailers Committee meeting scheduled for August 11 to discuss the bridge project.
