 - 1. Request for Variance from Accessory Building Standards to allow a 1,232 Sq. Ft. Building to be built in the front yard, 27 feet from the Side Lot Line instead of the required 50 feet, M. James Gunberg, 7556 Knapp St. NE, 41-15-10-326-004

James Gunberg, 7556 Knapp St. NE. Mr. Gunberg stated he would like to replace an existing building and is asking for the new building to stay in the same place as the old building. Mr. Gunberg stated it is not favorable to build any where else on the property. There are power lines and the driveway would be in the way if he were to build any where else.

Member Boman asked if there was an existing foundation and Mr. Gunberg stated there was and he planned on replacing the old foundation with a new.

2. Request for Variance from Sign Standards to allow a non-conforming sign to be altered, St. Robert of Newminister, 6477 Ada Dr., 41-15-33-101-027.

Father <u>SudlickSudlik</u>, Pastor of St. Robert presented the variance request. St. Robert would like to update the sign to something more modern and update the message board sign because the current one must be changed manually, which is difficult in winter.

Member Burton questioned if there would be a change in the size of the sign. The Applicant stated there would not be.

Member Lowry asked what color the message board would be, the applicant responded that it would be amber in color.

Planning Director Ferro stated the reason for the application is that our rules state the sign should not be altered. A bulletin board sign is permitted for church and schools and there are no rules for digitalized signs. Mr. Ferro stated there should be a condition specifically stating there is no scrolling, flashing, or animation.

Chairman Boman stated he wanted to provide flexibility for the church on the message and consider the time changes on which the sign changes.
