Request for Variance from Sign Standards in the AG Zoning District to allow a 25 square foot sign for a Veterinary Hospital, 1770 Grand River Dr, Gay Gira Lathrop/ Trish Vandenbrink for Ada Hospital for Animals, 41-15-18-176-002.

The applicants are present for the variance request. Dr. Lathrop and her partner are requesting new signage for the Veterinary Hospital. Dr. Lathrop stated a small focus light directly on the sign has been suggested by the sign company building the sign and it will be constructed out of soft wood.

Zoning Director Kushion stated the request would hold to the same standards as the AG Zoning District as the sign is not going to stand out or be objectionable. Mr. Kushion stated there was no communication from the neighbors, nor had anyone come in to the township to look at the sign.

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Member Korth asked if the actual street number would be on the sign or would the applicant be using a green township sign with the street number on it. The applicant stated they plan on leaving the current signage with the address there.

Moved by Member Korth to approve the variance request, with the following conditions recommended by the zoning administrator:

- 1. The sign shall not exceed 25 square feet (The max allowed in the C2 District).
- 2. No portion of the sign shall exceed 5 feet in height.
- 3. Any illumination of the sign shall be approved by the Zoning Administrator.
