### To Register:

\*Payment can be made with cash, money order or check: payable to Ada Township.

\*Credit card payments can be made in person at the Ada Township office for an additional fee.

### **Confirmation:**

- \*Once your form and payment is submitted, you will receive confirmation that you are registered.
- \*One week before each program, you will receive an e-mail with program details and an equipment list.

#### Wait List:

\*If a session is full, your child may be placed on a wait list. You will be notified when an opening occurs.

### **Discounts and Scholarships:**

- \*Participants may receive the Ada Township resident discount OR a scholarship, not both.
- \*Ada Township residents can receive a 10% discount on Day Camps and Kids' Garden.
- \*Scholarships are available to cover 50% of Day Camp and Kids Garden program fees.

To qualify, participants must be enrolled in the reduced/free lunch program at their school.

Scholarships are limited to one scholarship per summer per family.

To apply for a scholarship, contact the Ada Park office at 616-676-0520.

\*Contributions to the Scholarship Fund are always welcome.

### **Cancellation Policy:**

- \*Cancellations by the Parks Department due to special circumstances such as extreme weather, will be re-scheduled or refunded. If your child cannot come to the re-scheduled date, you may use your fee towards the cost of another program.
- \*Cancellations by participants 5 days or more prior to the program start date will be refunded or have the payment applied to another program. Processing fees of 10% will be applied to the refund.
- \*Cancelations by participants made less than 5 days prior to the start of a program will not be refunded.
- \*No refunds will be given for cancellations or absence once a program has begun.

Participants gain a "full season" experience from soil preparation and planting to harvest and sales. Learn to grow and manage a garden, sell your harvested produce at the Farmers Market and contribute to a food pantry. Participants earn a Jr. Master Gardener certificate.
