

ADA SEEKS CANDIDATES FOR DDA BOARD POSITION

Ada Township is inviting applications to fill a vacant position on its Downtown Development Authority (DDA) Board. The DDA is a special purpose governmental body created by the Township to facilitate revitalization of Ada Township's downtown district, which encompasses the Village and adjacent areas on the Fulton St. corridor. The 9-member Board meets monthly. State law requires that a majority of the Board members be property owners in the district, or owners or employees of businesses in the district. The Township is seeking applicants who meet this qualification.
